The mobility of the units make them the ideal solution for spill recovery on ships or in storage depots where there are confined spaces and restricted traffic flow. Any liquid, regardless of its viscosity, slurries, powders, or small solid particulates can be quickly "sucked up" by the unit and deposited into container vessels.
